RESIDENTIAL CAMP PACKING LIST

(This list applies to: 1 & 2 week residential camps, Sailing 101 & mini camp)

Equipment and Clothing

- Warm sleeping bag or sheets and blankets (remember: cabins often get cold at night, even during summer)
- Pillow

Double the * items for the 2 week sessions:

- *2 Long pants
- *2 Short pants
- *1 Long-sleeved shirt (at least)
- *5 Short-sleeved shirts
- *5 Underwear and socks
- *1 Towel
- Old Wool Socks & Clothes for “Muddling” [Blueberry Cove only]
- Swimsuit
- Hat
- 1 Sweater or sweatshirt (fleece)
- Waterproof Raincoat (no ponchos)
- Toiletries (soap, toothbrush, etc.)
- 2 Pair footwear (sneakers, etc.)
- Sandals for getting wet (no flip flops)
- Bug repellent (no aerosol spray cans or products with D.E.E.T.)
- Sunscreen
- Daypack
- Flashlight/headlamp with extra batteries (we have a battery charger!)
- Water bottle (reusable plastic beverage containers work great!)
- Small journal and pencil

Optional

- Compass
- Camera and film
- Fly fishing gear (must be kept with camp staff)
- Hiking boots
- Rubber boots or old sneakers
- Stationery, stamps, envelopes, pen and/or pencil
- Pajamas
- Bag for dirty clothes
- Favorite stuffed animal for sleeping

Please Avoid Bringing:

- Anything electrical or electronic (MP3 players, cell phones, etc)
- Aerosol spray cans
- Money
- Valuables
- Food!
- Weapons of any kind
- Drugs, alcohol, cigarettes
- Live animals or pets
- Vehicles (including bicycles)
- Sports equipment

NOTES: Storage in cabins is limited, so please pack efficiently.
Make a list of what your camper brings to camp and place it with their things.
This may help them remember what needs to be brought home!
