

**DIRECTIONS TO
DONALD P. CORBETT BUSINESS BUILDING
6 BEDDINGTON ROAD, ORONO
UNIVERSITY OF MAINE -ORONO**

I-95 to Exit 191 - Kelley Road.

If traveling from the South, turn right at the end of the ramp.

If traveling from the North, take a left at the end of the ramp.

Continue to the intersection of U.S. Route 2 (this road is also Main Street, Orono). Turn left onto U.S. Route 2 - Main Street. Near the center of town, you will pass a fire station and a convenience store on the left, and cross a bridge shortly after that. The University Inn Academic Suites will be on your left just after the bridge.

Stay to the right and bear right at the traffic light across from the University Inn Academic Suites onto Park Street (a continuation of U.S. Route 2).

The Park Street entrance to the University of Maine is located on the left about 1/2 mile after the traffic light.

Turn left into campus, just before Bangor Savings Bank.

Bear left at the first fork in the road onto the Belgrade Spur.

The Collins Center for the Arts (CCA) is located just ahead.

The Donald P. Corbett Business Building is to the right of the CCA.

Parking is available throughout campus for visitor and conference parking in lots marked Commuter (C - Black). ***Park in the CCA Lot***

Parking permits are required for all vehicles on Monday – Friday. Permits are not required after normal working hours and on weekends or holidays.

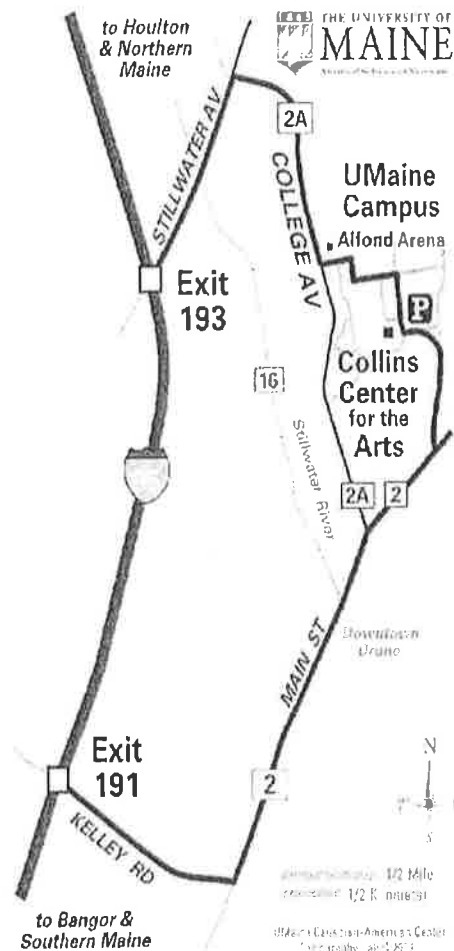
If a parking permit has not already been sent to you, please pick one up when you check in at the registration area in D. P. Corbett.

Commuter Parking

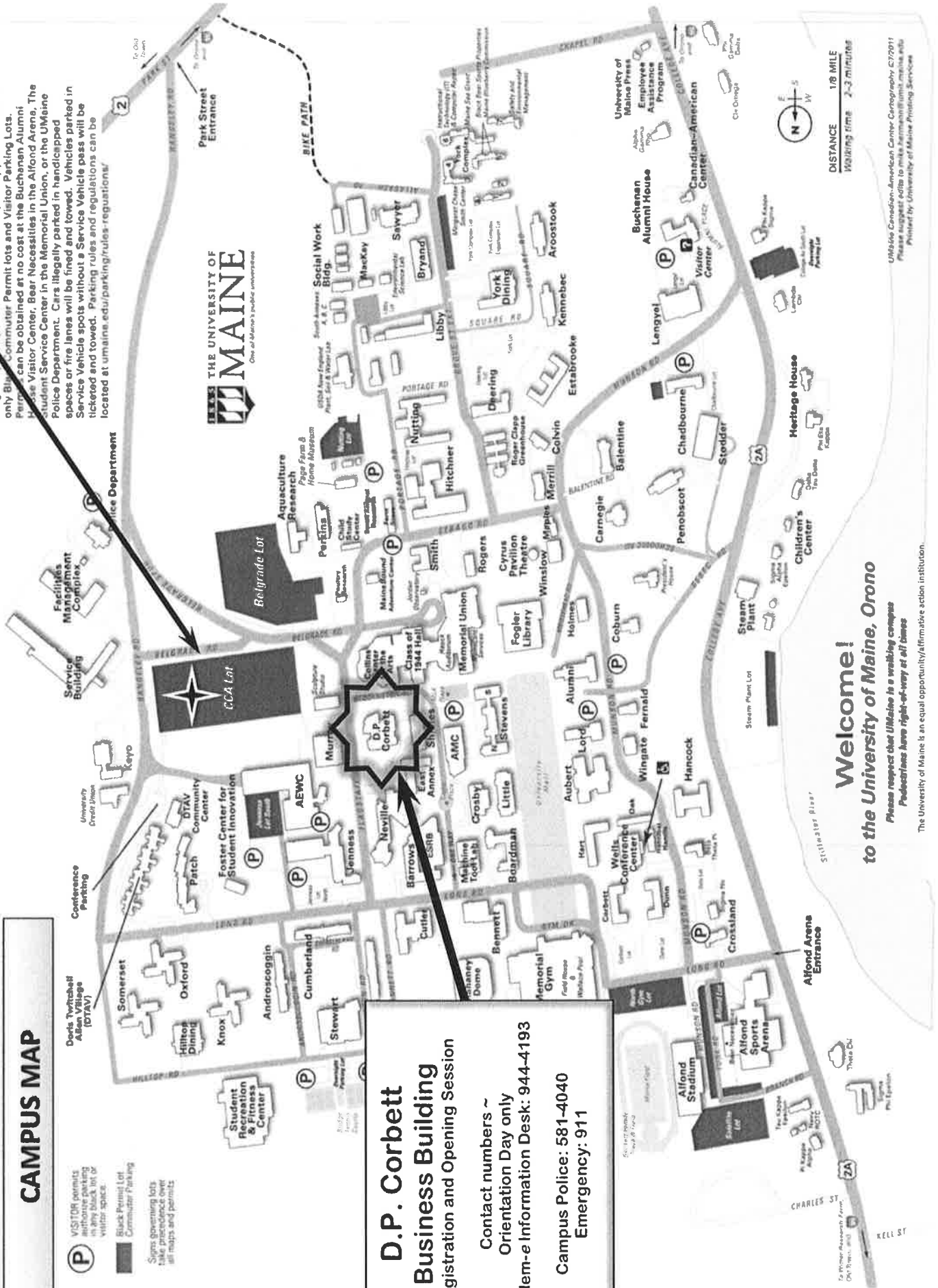

PARKING NOTICE

Program participants and visitors must park by permit and use only Black Commuter Permit lots and Visitor Parking Lots. Permits can be obtained at no cost at the Buchanan Alumni Middle Visitor Center, Bear Necessities in the Alford Arena, The Student Service Center in the Memorial Union, or the UMaine Police Department. Cars illegally parked in handicapped spaces or fire lanes will be fined and towed. Vehicles parked in Service Vehicle spots without a Service Vehicle pass will be ticketed and towed.
