

GMAT Waiver Request Name: Email: Option 1: Advanced Academic Credentials • A PhD, JD, MD, or master's degree from an approved, accredited program A recognized industry designation such as CPA, CMA, CFA, or equivalent · Successful completion of 9 credits with a B or higher for Business Administration Certificate Students • A graduate of one of the five U.S. service academies: o US Military Academy, US Naval Academy, US Air Force Academy, US Merchant Marine Academy, US Coast Guard Academy Applicant must provide official transcripts in the admissions process to confirm Advanced Academic Credentials Option 2: Professional Experience Five or more years of post-graduate professional or military work experience that includes any one of the following: Management of staff in a direct working relationship Financial or budgetary responsibility Applied quantitative and analytical skills · Leadership of military work teams (e.g., platoon leader, platoon commander, team leader, company commander, and similar military positions) Qualifying experience must be outlined on resume/CV and verifiable with the employer if needed. Option 3: Industry experience in a STEM (science, engineering, technology and mathematics), quantitative or analytical environment Three or more years of industry experience in a STEM field or a highly quantitative or analytical environment Qualifying experience must be outlined on resume/CV and verifiable with employer if needed. Option 4: At least 3 years of advanced military operations experience, including, but not limited to the following: • U.S. Army RANGER U.S. Navy SEAL • U.S. Air Force Para Jumper • U.S. Marine Corps Force Reconnaissance Designation Special Operations SIPER or Jumpmaster Designator Applicant must provide orders Option 5: An Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or above in a STEM (science, engineering, technology and mathematics) or applied quantitative field A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above from an undergraduate degree that included coursework in a STEM (e.g., engineering, science, math) or applied quantitative field (business, economics, analytics, etc.) from an approved accredited program Applicant must provide official transcripts Option 6: Test scores in the 50th percentile or higher from the LSAT, PCAT, GRE or MCAT Applicant must provide official score report Option 7: 4+1 or Accelerated Pathway University of Maine System (UMS) Student UMS Students eligible for the 4+1 or accelerated pathway programs qualify for a GMAT waiver University of Maine students interested in pursuing the 4+1 must apply and be approved for 4+1 status. All other UMaine, UMS, and partner program students must provide a copy of their Accelerated Pathways Declaration of Intent with their application materials.
