- Open to all Graduate students who wish to improve their French proficiency in Canada
- The Award covers tuition and fees up to \$5000 and offers a \$3000 stipend
- Credits can be transferred to UMaine

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a US citizen or permanent resident
- Must be at the Intermediate or advanced level in French
- Must be enrolled or accepted in a full-time Graduate program at UMaine
- Must be enrolled in a 6-week intensive summer language study (140 contact hours) in French
