

INT 196: Academic & Career Exploration Field Experience

This course provides an opportunity for students to receive academic credit for an internship or career exploration experience. Prior approval is required and will be based on a detailed written plan and documentation presented by the student and approved by the student's Faculty Advisor/Instructor and the Director of the Career Center. This course is open to all students (except first year, first-semester students) in all majors who are in good academic standing. This course is only available to students who do not have an internship/field experience course within their major. Prerequisite: permission. Credits: 1-3. Grade may be Pass/Fail or letter grade. Course may be repeated for a maximum of 6 credits. Course is offered during the fall and spring semesters and during summer sessions.

Students may not enroll in this course and receive academic credit after the internship has been completed or once the add/drop period for the semester has ended.

In order to receive permission to take this course, the Prior Approval Form with an attached learning contract must be completed and turned into the Career Center, 300 Memorial Union or emailed to cblackie@maine.edu.

Upon completion of INT 196, the student will meet with their faculty advisor/instructor for a review and evaluation of how well the student met the learning contract requirements; the faculty advisor/instructor will then recommend a grade for INT 196 and submit it to the Director of the Career Center.
