The University of Maine campus has a wide variety of attractive multi-purpose spaces, as well as classrooms, auditoriums, and conference rooms, that are ideal for professional conferences, educational trainings, symposiums, workshops, and informational gatherings. All our traditional meeting spaces include standard, built-in technology for video projection and sound, computer access, laptop connections, a central control station, and on-site technological support. The university has a dedicated, free guest Wi-Fi network with easy authentication for all visitors and guests. There is ample free parking available near many of the traditional meeting spaces, with the added ability to reserve specific parking for your group for a small cost.

A Scenic Wonderland

Located along the Stillwater and Penobscot Rivers, the University's hometown of Orono is named in honor of Chief Joseph Orono of the indigenous Penobscot tribe. Orono is 9 miles from the city of Bangor, the core business and commercial hub of central and northern Maine.

A short drive to the east, guests can travel to the town of Bar Harbor and spend a day in Acadia National Park. Head north to the terminus of the Appalachian Trail at Mt. Katahdin, Maine's highest mountain. To the south is the vibrant city of Portland, the largest city in the state and home to a bustling Old Port neighborhood great for exploring unique shops and restaurants. Finally, to the west is Quebec, the Francophile province of Canada.

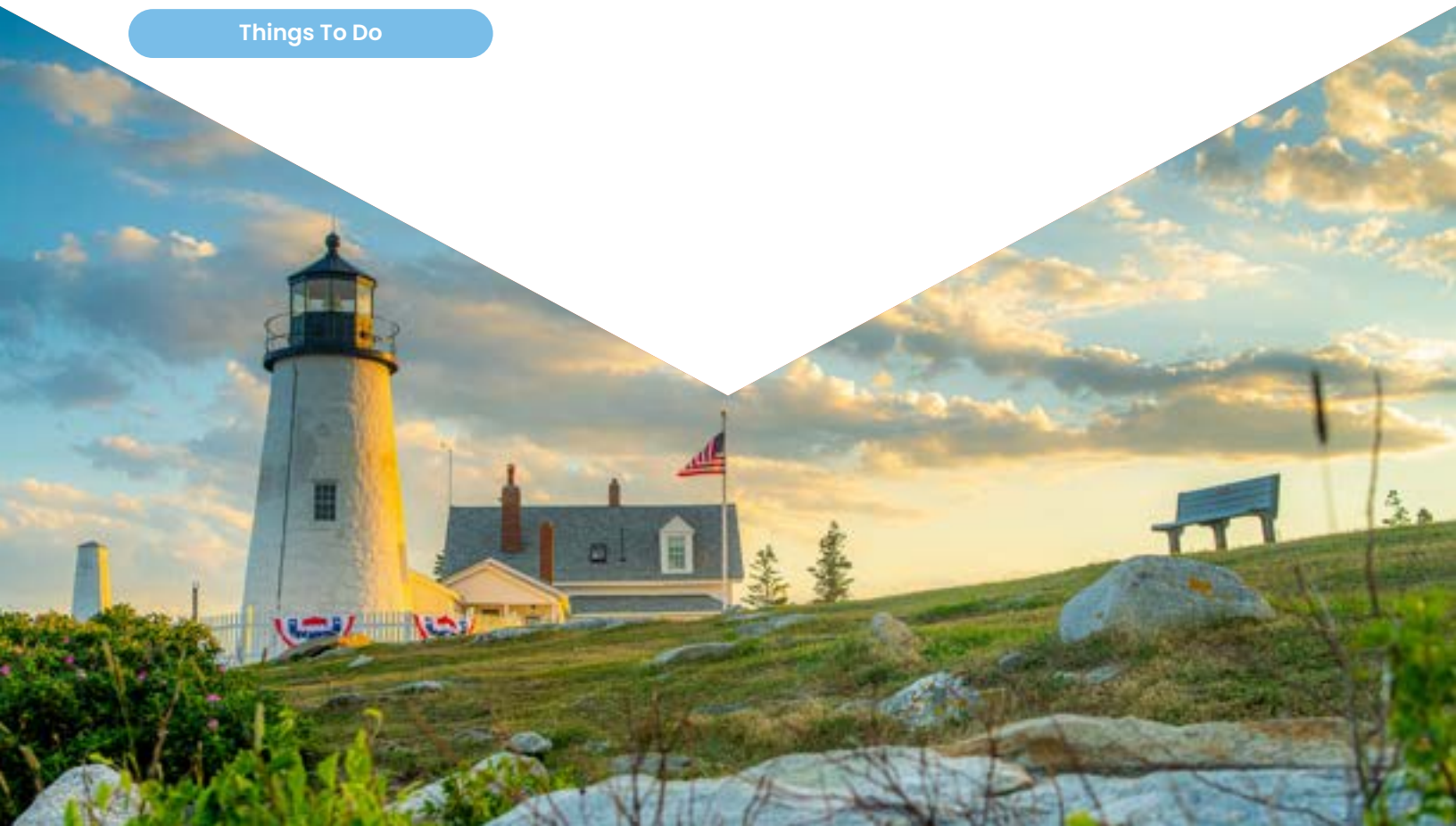

By Car

The Town of Orono is easily accessed via I-95 through central Maine. Take exit 193 to Stillwater and head east. Continue on Stillwater for 0.8 miles until you reach the fourth traffic light, then turn right onto College Avenue. After 1 mile, turn left on to Long Road. Parking is on your left. Parking at the University requires a parking pass. You will be provided with information on parking at the time your event is arranged. Details on where parking is available is found by clicking below. There are dedicated e-chargers on campus for visitors with electric vehicles.

By Air

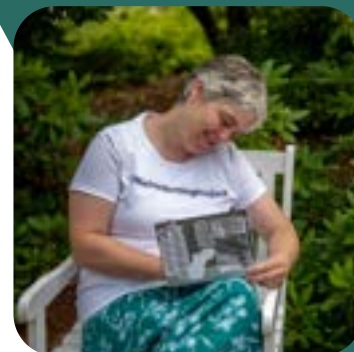
Bangor International Airport is 20 minutes from the University of Maine and services many major airlines.
