



STEM Exploration Course

- STEM research exploration course (INT 188, three-credit) which involves field- and laboratory-based data collection, analysis and lecture.
- Experiential four to six-week course, located on the UMaine campus.
- Group-based research projects and career planning exercises.
- Final project-based research symposium at the end of the course.



Outdoor Leadership Program

- 10 day intensive program composed of KPE 207 (one-credit) and KPE 265 (three-credit).
- Students can earn certifications in Wilderness First Aid and CPR.
- Residential experience at a 4-H learning center in Maine.
- Program includes multiple adventure experiences combined with certifications.



Cohen Leadership Summer Institute

- Five-week online LDR 100 (three-credit) course. Fully residential for one week with students housed on UMaine campus.
- Interaction and experiences with prominent leaders from Maine and beyond.
- Students selected through high school administrator nomination process. Interested students should reach out to school counselors for more information.



Career and College Ready Summer Program

- INT 193 (two-credit) course in career exploration and academic success. Fully residential for one week with students housed on UMaine campus.
- New Mainer students selected through high school administrator nomination process.
