

**No-cost UMaine Early College course credit this summer!**



## Program description:

- Fully residential program on the UMaine campus in Orono, June 26–July 2, 2022
- Students will be housed in a campus residence hall with all meals provided
- Academic course, LDR 100: Foundations of Leadership, for three credits of Early College credit (this course takes place online two weeks prior and two weeks after the live portion)
- Numerous activities, seminars, and site visits with prominent leaders from Maine
- Some pre- and post-work required

## Student requirements for nomination:

- Must have completed junior year in high school and be a rising senior
- High school overall GPA of 3.5 or higher strongly encouraged
- High school overall GPA of 3.0–3.4 will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis
- Demonstrated success or interest in leadership positions in extracurricular programs (athletics, clubs, student organizations, community groups, etc.)
- Show particular promise and interest in public service leadership
- Mature and professionally engaged
- Committed to being present for the entire live portion of the course: June 26–July 2
