

M.Ed. in Educational Leadership

Now online, low-residency format

School leaders need to be prepared for fostering trusting and collaborative relationships with staff, families and students. Leaders need to gain knowledge of learning and organizational dynamics — including leading groups, instructional supervision, and stakeholder engagement — and cultivate a better understanding of themselves as leaders.

- Earn your M.Ed in Educational Leadership from your home or office
- 80% of classes will be offered through Zoom, 20% in-person weekend meetings
- 13 course experience – 40 credits including internship experience
- Cohort approach allows peer relationships to grow and deepen over time



Schedule & Location: Classes are offered over a three-year period beginning Fall 2019. Designed for the working practitioner, classes meet most weeks from 5–7:30 p.m. through video conferencing software and two or three Saturdays for face-to-face leadership work. Saturday classes will be held from 8:30–2:30 p.m. at the Hutchinson Center in Belfast, ME.

Application deadline: Your application must be received by the UMaine Graduate School by June 1, 2019 (umaine.edu/graduate/apply). In addition, notify Janice Bacon your intent to be part of the 2019 cohort by phone (207.581.3119) or email (janiceb@maine.edu). The GRE/MAT are no longer required.

When will I find out if I've been accepted? The Graduate School will typically send a letter regarding your application within 4-6 weeks.
