

#### UNIVERSITY OF MAINE FLYING CLUB

At the recent meeting of the Flying Club on Wednesday, November 5, it was decided that since the majority of the prospective members could not come up with a large initiation fee at this time, interest would be kept alive via a groundschool and payment of dues toward the purchase of a plane next spring.

The following plan was agreed upon by those present:

- 1. Dues will be \$10.00 a month for five months to be held in escrow.
- 2. A ground school will be conducted during the five months at no extra cost. This will involve about two hours a week.
- At the end of this five month period, bases on a membership of twentyfive, the club should have sufficient funds to begin the purchase of an airplane and start getting in some flying time.

If at the end of these five months there is not sufficient interest, then all money will be refunded, less expenses incurred during the five month period.

It will be held Wednesday, November 12 in Room 35, Education at 7:30 p.m. At this time a slate of officers will be leected and the first payment of dues for the month of November will be collected. The amount of dues collected at this meeting will be vital to the continuation of the club.
