

# University of Maine Campus Highlights

You will be provided an opportunity to have a guided tour with an orientation volunteer. This sheet will provide you with important spots for future references as you acclimate yourself to campus.

## **The Memorial Union**

Location of the University Bookstore, Computer Connection, MaineCard Office, VETS office, student access computers and printing, ATM machines, University Credit Union, The Cubby Post Office, Rainbow Resource Center (LGBT Services Room 224) Student Wellness Center (Room 235), Multicultural Office, Career Center, Commuter Lounge (Room 228) Office of Student Affairs, Information Booth, bus stop, and meals.

The Union also holds the parking pass office (Mainecard Office) \$50 parking pass for one year. It's Important that your pass is always in your vehicle and that you park in designated areas. Otherwise you will be ticketed/towed.

## **The Collins Center for the Arts (CCA)**

International and domestic performs of music; theatre, dance, and comedy perform here. Some shows can be accessed for free with your Maine Card (will need to call the CCA for details on which shows).

## **Raymond H. Fogler Library**

- 1st floor – reference books, study tables, computers/printing/copying/scanning, Collaborative Media Lab, Inter Library Loan, government publications, newspapers, library help desks, the Oakes Room. Some special printing options as well, for things like posters.
- 2nd floor – Periodicals, science and engineering center, children's books.
- 3rd floor – Quiet floor. Special collections.

## **Alumni Hall**

Houses the Bursar's office, where you can pay your bill. Also houses the Dean of the Graduate School and the Office of the President.

## **Fernald Hall**

Houses the Women's, Gender and Sexuality Department and the Women's Resource Center.

## **Wingate Hall**

Houses the office of Financial Aid and Student Employment.

## **Shibles**

Houses IT support services and many education departments.

**East Annex**

Houses the Disability Support Services office, where you can access accommodations.

**Neville Hall**

Houses the Writing Center on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor and the Math Lab on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor.

**Cutler Health Center**

Offers flu shots and some basic medical care. Volunteer Ambulance. Walk in care from 10a.m. - 3 p.m. Also offers massages and physical therapy.

**Counseling Center**

Students taking 6 credits are eligible for individual counseling. Limited number of sessions free to students during the academic year.

**Student Recreation and Fitness Center**

Built in 2007 and is certified green. Come here for personal trainers, intramurals; some free classes for like kickboxing or zumba, other classes offered for a student fee. There is basketball courts, raquet ball, dance rooms with mirrors, pool, sauna, hot tub.

**Athletic Facilities**

As a student, you will get free access to ALL UMaine home sporting events with your MaineCard.

- *Alfond Arena*: home of the UMaine Black Bear Hockey Team.
- *Field House*: indoor track open to the public at select times.
- *Alfond Stadium*: home to the football team. UMaine is the only Division I school in the state of Maine.

**Stodder**

Houses the UMaine Graduate School offices. General questions about policy and forms for graduate school can be sent here. Housing for graduate students. This is also where you will drop off theses/dissertations. Graduate Student Government Board meets here.
