Fall 2022 Grants Report

In the fall 2022 grants cycle, we had a total of 73 applications submitted, and 68 of those were awarded funds. 4 of the rejected applications had the incorrect application number entered on the form, which led to identification of the application. The other rejected application had a citation of their advisor which was identified in their application. Continuing overall, the amount requested was \$57,783.69, and we awarded a total of \$38.274.80 in awards. Our budget for the fall 2022 grants cycle was \$31,500.00 so we exceeded our budget by 121%. Applicants were funded at amounts ranging from 100%, 80%, 75%, 70%, 60%, or 50% (see table 1 for breakdown).

For Degree Related applications, we had 40 applications and the total amount requested was \$32,141.16, and we were able to award 36 applicants with a total of \$19,042.41. We had 23 applications for equipment & supplies, 12 applications for professional development, and 1 application for travel for research.

For Travel to Present applications, we had 32 applications, with a total request of \$28,556.05, and we were able to award 32 applicants a total of \$19,232.40.

For reimbursement applications, we had 12 applicants with a total request of \$9.489.91, and we were able to award 11 applicants with a sum of \$8,128.67.
