Fall 2023 Grants Report

In the Fall 2023 grants cycle, we had a total of 87 applications submitted, and 76 of those were awarded funds. The amount requested was \$68,333.27, and we awarded a total of \$40,134.09 in awards. Our budget for the fall 2023 grants cycle was \$34,000. Applicants were funded at amounts ranging from 100%, 70%, 60% or 50% (see table 1 for breakdown).

For Degree Related applications, we had 42 applications and the total amount requested was \$33,220.32, and we were able to award 35 applicants with a total of \$18,800.97. We had 18 applications for equipment and supplies, requesting \$13,684.22 and we awarded \$9,315.18. We had 9 applications for professional development, requesting \$7,258.88 and we awarded \$4,739.91. We had 8 applications for travel for research, requesting \$6,648.4, and we awarded \$4,745.88.

For Travel to Present applications, we had 45 applications, with a total request of \$35,112.97, and we were able to award 41 applicants a total of \$21,333.12.

From the total applications, we had 19 applicants requesting a total of \$13,721.87 for reimbursement, and we awarded 16 applicants with a sum of \$7933.25, the other 3 applications were rejected. Reimbursement applications had the same scoring threshold as the other applications.
