Spring 2023 Grants Report

In the spring 2023 grants cycle, we had a total of 116 applications submitted, and 103 of those were awarded funds. The amount requested was \$96,155.30, and we awarded a total of \$55,125.36 in awards. Our budget for the spring 2023 grants cycle was \$55,125.87. Applicants were funded at amounts ranging from 100%, 70%, or 50% (see table 1 for breakdown).

For Degree Related applications, we had 46 applications and the total amount requested was \$36,722.43, and we were able to award 40 applicants with a total of \$22,598.49. We had 24 applications for equipment and supplies, requesting \$18,442.65 and we awarded \$13,141.89. We had 8 applications for professional development, requesting \$4,889.07 and we awarded \$3,246.83. We had 14 applications for travel for research, requesting \$13,391.01, and we awarded \$6,209.77.

For Travel to Present applications, we had 70 applications, with a total request of \$59,432.87, and we were able to award 63 applicants a total of \$32,527.38.

For reimbursement applications, we had 12 applicants with a total request of \$9,057.50, and we were able to award 9 applicants with a sum of \$5,797.94. Reimbursement applications had a scoring threshold of 90 or above being awarded 100%, and scores of 89-80 receiving 90% funding.
