Religion as Culture: The Social Evolution of Big Gods

PSY/RST, 400-level, 3 credits

- Students will examine the social evolutionary psychology of the development of Big Gods across cultures and experimentally examine the effects of belief in supernatural watchers in the local culture in which they're studying. The course will ask students to master upper-level content in the psychology of religion and will facilitate that mastery by asking students to carefully examine how these cultural and psychological processes function in their host culture.
- Combine with a course on Basque culture.

Cultural Social Psychology

PSY, 200-level, 3 credits

- This course will examine cultural influences on the construction of the self and on other social psychological constructs and functions. This course is designed for students with a limited background in psychology and will leverage the cultural experiences the students are immersed in to reveal the power of culture on individual thoughts, feelings, and behavior.
- Combine with a course on Spanish culture.
