

Application Instructions

Students are required to meet with the Study Abroad Advisor prior to applying in order to identify and select a program which is a good fit academically, culturally and financially.

Eligibility Requirements

- be enrolled at UMaine full-time in the semester prior to studying abroad
- have completed two semesters of college by the start of the study abroad program
- 2.5 minimum cumulative GPA required (3.0 for most direct exchange programs)
- good academic and disciplinary standing
- meet foreign language proficiency requirements, if needed

Application Deadlines

Please note that UMaine has a rolling admissions policy. Students are strongly encouraged to apply as early as possible as some programs, particularly direct exchange programs, fill prior to the deadlines:

February 20 – for Summer, Fall and Academic Year programs

October 15 – for Spring programs

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can I submit my application form, fee and photo separately?

A: We prefer to receive them all together.

Q: What kind of photo is required for this application?

A: A small photo of the student's face is requested for office use only. Black and white or color photos printed by the students are acceptable, as long as they fit in the outlined photo dimensions.

Q: Is my UMaine study abroad application fee refundable?

A: Once the application form and fee is processed, the fee is not refundable.

Q: What if I am applying to the same program at the same location for more than one semester or summer term?

A: Submit only one application and one fee for both programs indicating the correct period of time abroad.

Q: Can I apply to two different programs at two different locations consecutively? For example,

- (a) fall at API France and spring at USAC Spain or
- (b) Summer I at USAC Spain and Summer II at USAC Germany?

A: Yes, just submit an application form and fee for each separate program. Check with the Study Abroad Advisor about the visa requirements for each program/destination.

Q: My GPA is lower than the required GPA. Can I still apply to study abroad?

A: Make an appointment with the Study Abroad Advisor to discuss your GPA and study abroad plans.

Q: Can I defer my study abroad application to a later time?

A: Once your application form and fee is process by the Office of International Programs, you cannot roll over your application fee if deferring your study abroad to a later time.

Q: What if I decide to extend my study abroad program?

A: While abroad, if while abroad you decide to extend for another semester/term, contact the Study Abroad Advisor immediately. A new application form and fee will be required for the added period abroad.
