Course Numbers:

100-199 are first year level

200-299 are sophomore level

Grading Scale:

A (4.0), A- (3.67), B+ (3.33), B (3.0), B- (2.67), C+ (2.33), C (2.0), C- (1.67), D+ (1.33), D (1.0), F (0.00). UMaine requires an average grade of C (2.0) as a passing grade and for graduation.

Registration:

Undergraduate Level: Students must be enrolled full-time for at least 12 credit hours and a maximum of 15 credits which is 4-5 courses.

Graduate Level: Students must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours and a maximum of 9 credits which is 2-3 courses.

Eligibility

Students must have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.75 out of 4.0 GPA and be in good disciplinary standing

English Proficiency:

Non-native English speakers must have a minimum test scores of 550 iTP (paper) or 79 iBT (internet) on the TOEFL or a 6.5 composite score on the IELTS

Students who do not submit these scores on time or fall below these scores will be required to enroll in the Intensive English Institute (IEI) at UMaine.
