Entrance Requirements and Adjustment Programs for International Elementary and High School Students
Orono / Old Town / Bangor Public Schools

Required Documentation

1. Parent's Visa

• for proof of legal entry into the U.S.

2. Child's Birth Certificate

3. Immunization Records

- in English translation, if possible
- must be immunized to US standards before starting classes
- immunization clinics available
- may be eligible for immunization waiver

4. School Records

• to help determine the education level of the child

5. Religious/Immunization Waivers

- if child's religious beliefs prohibit immunization, child may be eligible to waive the immunization requirements
- to notify school officials of religious holidays when the child will be absent from classes

Adjustment Programs

Ask about availability and access to these kinds of programs:

1. Education / Language Evaluation

- English-as-a-Second-Language (ESL) testing to determine child's proficiency; testing provided by certified language assessment team
 - Schools will also test the child's ability level in reading, writing, math, and speech

2. Vision / Hearing / Health Evaluations and Clinics

- Evaluations are offered for testing the child's vision, hearing and other health conditions that may affect the child's learning
- Free or Low-Cost programs and clinics are sometimes available for updating the child's immunizations and purchasing health supplies at low-cost

3. In-Class Support

• In-class tutoring may be available to help children adjust to the classroom setting and to assist with in-class learning

4. Counseling and 1-on-1 Support

- Individual counseling offered to children who have difficulty adjusting socially and scholastically
- Programs available to help those with special needs and disabilities

5. School Transfer

• Children go to the school nearest to their residence, NOT necessarily the school nearest to the Orono campus. Permission forms are available for those parents who wish to transfer their children to a different school.
