The course section is designed to be delivered:	Official Instruction Mode Description (Code)	Definition
Entirely online. All classes are fully online with no scheduled online meetings.	Online (WW)	A course section where 100% of course activity and class meetings are completed asynchronously (i.e., not in real time) online with no required online meeting times.
Entirely online. Classes are fully online with required online meeting times for all or part of the course.	Distance Synchronous Learning (DS)	These classes never meet in person. The course is taught online, and the instructor is expected to deliver instruction synchronously (i.e., in real time) at the times for which the class is scheduled.
Both online & in-person. There is a mix of in-person scheduled class meetings and online components.	Hybrid/Blended (HB)	These classes have both in-person and online components. The dates/times of in-person meetings are scheduled.

Offer Numbers

Offer numbers have an important role for classes for correct funding sources. It is important that the proper coding is used for instruction mode, offer numbers and section numbers. Onload classes for instructors are not coded as offer 20 (DLL sections). Please note that if class instructors are changed, coding also needs to be changed to appropriately reflect onload/overload status. Changes should be made prior to student enrollment and BrightSpace class shells being created.

- **1, 4:** Department Funded; Instructor Onload
- **5, 6, 25, 26, 35, 36, 45, 46** (etc.): **These are offer numbers for Cross-listed courses and are based on how they are built in the MaineStreet catalog. Cross-listed courses have the same catalog description (used for undergrad/grad courses with the same designator or courses with different designators, i.e., BMB 150 and HON 150). (These are NOT synonymous with a “Combined Section!”)**
- **10:** Center for Responsive Training classes used by the College of EDHD
- **15:** Academ-e for early college students
- **20:** DLL Funded and requires DLL approval
- **30:** University-wide Section Project Funded classes
- **40:** Classes that are Cross-listed with other UMS Universities
- **51:** UMaine Revenue Sharing Programs for EDT

What does offer 40 mean? UM uses course offer 40 for classes that are held at two (or more) UMS Universities and UM is not the campus that originates the class. This impacts revenue sharing. Example: A class is being taught at Machias and UMaine has an offer 40 DS (online live) section to join the class at Machias.

For summer, there are new DLL sections for summer university day classes 0800-0819, how do we code summer classes that are not funded by DLL for summer? Summer classes like thesis that are not funded by DLL are coded as offer 1 (or 4 for Machias), instruction mode of AR and sections 0001-0179.

Instruction Modes and Smart Section Numbers

P-In Person

The P-In Person code is our most widely used instruction mode and has the most variation for section coding. These classes are being taught 100% face to face, in classrooms. The following codes are used for the P In-Person instruction mode:

- **Offer 1 or 4: Sections 0001-0179, 1001 & Up (Labs), 2001 & Up (Recitations)** - Department funded classes, Instructor Onload

Instruction Modes and Smart Section Numbers

HB-Hybrid/Blended

HB-Hybrid/Blended classes have both in-person and online components. The dates/times of in-person meetings are scheduled. It does not matter the amount of each mode, if the class has any amount of in-person and online sessions, the class is considered Hybrid/Blended. It is recommended to make a note indicating the frequency of online or in-person components so students are aware. The following codes are used for the HB Hybrid/Blended instruction mode:

- **Offer 1 or 4: Sections 0001-0179, 1001 & Up (Labs), 2001 & Up (Recitations)** - Department funded classes, Instructor Onload
- **Offer 10: Sections 0001-0179, 1001 & Up (Labs), 2001 & Up (Recitations)** - Center for Responsive Training classes used by the College of EDHD
- **Offer 20 (DLL Funded classes):**
 - **Sections 0300-0379** - Bridge year Program classes taught in area High Schools, usually year-long
 - **Sections 0665-0668; 0669** - Classes at the Belfast Hutchinson Center (FHC). **0669** is the Video Conferencing option that goes between FHC/UM

WW-Online classes are classes where 100% of activity and meetings are completed asynchronously online (i.e., not in real time) with no required online meeting times. The following codes are used for the WW Online instruction mode:

Instruction Modes and Smart Section Numbers

DS-Distance Synchronous

Distance synchronous classes never meet in person. The class is taught online, and the instructor is expected to deliver instruction synchronously (i.e., in real time) at the times for which the class is scheduled. Even if there are only a few synchronous meetings and the rest of the material is covered asynchronously, the class should be coded as DS so students are aware of what they are signing up for. Notes can be added to the class to further educate the students on what is expected. The following codes are used for the DS Distance Synchronous instruction mode:

The AR - By Arrangement instruction mode's time and location are to be determined by the instructor. These are classes that are meant for clinical placements, field placements, independent studies, internships, theses, and research hours. Though they do not require a scheduled room or time, they are considered to be in "in person." The following codes are used for the AR By Arrangement instruction mode:

SD-Split Delivery

Split Delivery classes will meet during all scheduled class times. However, groups of students in the class will alternate in-person and virtual attendance as designated by the instructor to maintain reduced density in classrooms (i.e., platoon system). These are different from Hybrid classes, where content is presented online and in-person on *different days*, but a Split Delivery is offering online and in-person simultaneously in order to break up the enrollment count for the in-person meeting. The following codes are used for the SD Split Delivery instruction mode:
