PATFA Evaluation Process

- 1. Part-time faculty will be placed in the PATFA unit when the part-time faculty member has been employed for at least two of the four immediately preceding semesters (fall or spring) and is so employed in the current semester.
- 2. Once in the unit, PATFA members are to be evaluated in the fourth semester of service and every fourth subsequent semester of service (i.e. teaching) at a campus.
