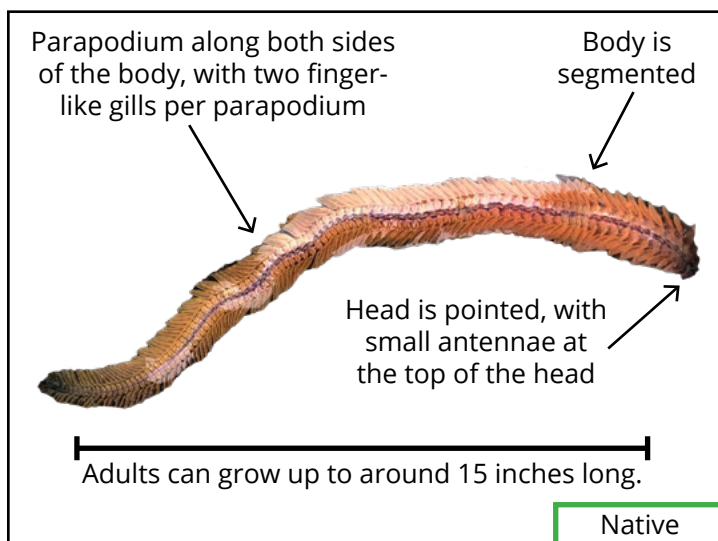

Bloodworm

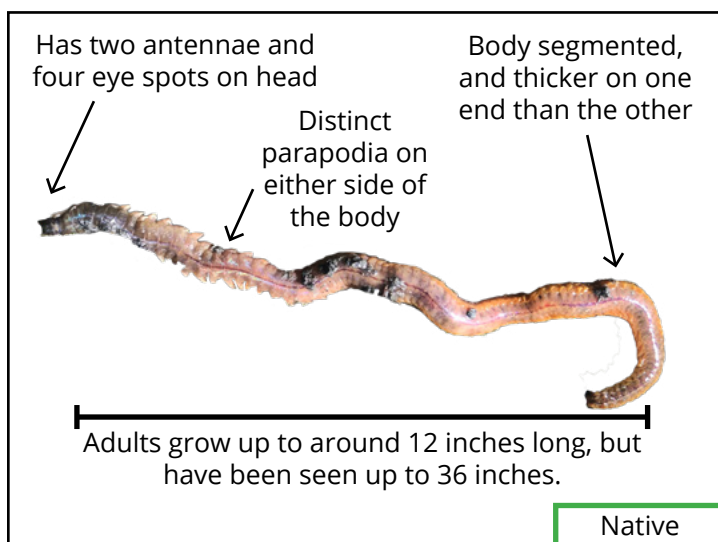
Glycera dibranchiata

Sandworm

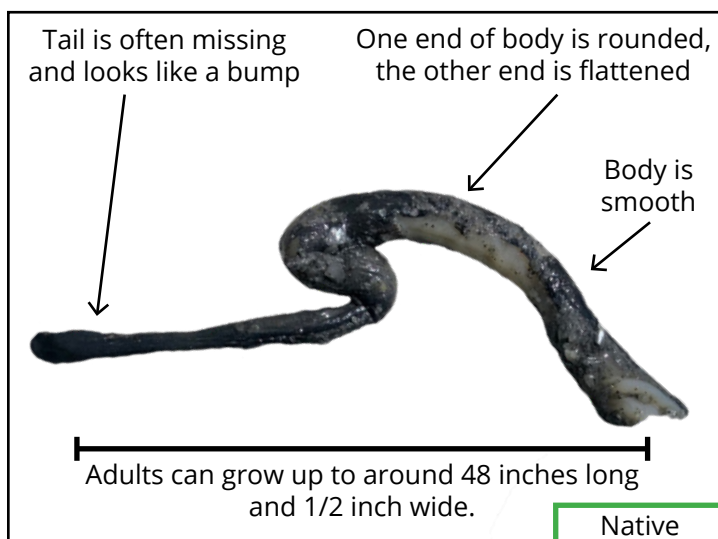
Nereis virens



Lives in estuaries, intertidal, or subtidal zones in sand, mud, or hard rocky substrates.

Milky Ribbon Worm

Cerebratulus lacteus



Lives in estuaries, intertidal, or subtidal zones in sand and mud.



Brown, pink, or white colored¹.
