

**HONORS PROGRAM ADDENDUM
TO THE MECHANICAL ENGINEERING CURRICULUM
(For students starting in Fall 2019)**

Mechanical Engineering Degree with Honors

The following changes to the “non-Honors” MEE Curriculum are suggested to complete the program in four years.

Year 1 Fall (15 cr.)

Remove ENG 101 (3 cr.) & HVSC Elective (3 cr.)
Add HON 111 (4 cr.)

Spring (18 cr.)

Remove HVSC Elective (3 cr.)
Add HON 112 (4 cr.)

Year 2 Fall (18 cr.)

Remove HVSC Elective (3 cr.)
Add HON 211 (4 cr.)

Spring (17 cr.)

Remove ENG 320
Add HON 212 (4 cr.)

Year 3 Fall (15-18 cr.)

Add HON 3XX (0-3 cr.) *Honors Tutorial, or Tutorial Alternative, or Honors Seminar*

Spring (15 cr.)

Remove MEE Technical Elective (3 cr.)
Add ENG 320 “Technical Communication for Engineering” (3 cr.)

Year 4 Fall (15 cr.)

Remove one MEE Technical Elective (3 cr.)
Add HON 498 (3 cr.)

Spring (17 cr.)

Remove two HVSC Electives (6 cr.)
Add MEE Tech Elective (3 cr.)
Add HON 499 (3 cr.) *Note: This course may replace one MEE Technical Elective with advisor approval*

Required prior to Graduation:

HON 170 (1 cr.) and HON 180 (1 cr.)

Honors Curriculum

The Honors Curriculum is a 24-27 credit program. To graduate with Honors students must have a 3.30 GPA at the time of graduation and complete:

- The Civilizations Sequence (years 1 and 2) with a “C” or better in each course and an overall GPA of 3.00.
- Honors 180 (A Cultural Odyssey) and Honors 170 (Currents & Contexts) in any year.
- The Honors Tutorial or Tutorial Alternative (typically in the third-year).
- The Honors Thesis (typically in the fourth-year)

Satisfying College Composition & HVSC Requirements

- Successful (“C” or better) completion of HON 111 and HON 112 waives the college composition (ENG 101) requirement.
- Completing the Civilization I – IV sequence is 16 credits, whereas the HVSC requirement is 18 credits. Taking HON 170 & HON 180 will provide the two additional required credits. Taking an Honors tutorial will almost always provide the additional needed credits as well.
- The table below details how the HVSC and Ethics categories are satisfied after each completed semester of the Civilizations Sequence.
