BA in ROMANCE LANGUAGES

A. General Requirements:

- a. Demonstration of listening comprehension, oral, reading, and writing proficiency. Students who have not received at least a “B” in FRE 305 or 306 and SPA 305 or 306 may be required to take a test in language skills.
- b. Demonstration of comprehensive coverage of literature and civilization through successful completion of appropriate coursework

B. Special Requirements:

- a. A minimum of 30 hours in French and Spanish beyond the intermediate level, at least 24 of which must be in the 400 series; a minimum of 12 hours above the intermediate level in each of the two languages:
