

## Credit by Examination

Students who have studied French or Spanish for three or more years in high school may opt for credit by examination at the intermediate level. No credit is awarded for elementary language courses.

In order to obtain credit by examination:

1. Take the online placement test, or login to retrieve your previous results (for tests taken prior to June 2020). Print your results or save a copy as a PDF file.
2. Bring your printed placement test results and proof of your grade in the completed course to the chairperson at 201 Williams Hall, or [email as PDF files to the department](#) with a request for credit by examination.
3. When you are placed into the 300 level or higher, complete at least two French or Spanish courses at the 300 level or above with a grade of B or higher to receive 6 credits for Intermediate I (FRE 201/ SPA 203) and Intermediate II (FRE 202 / SPA 204).

The chairperson will determine which credits are to be awarded and will write a letter to the Office of Student Records, which will post the credits to your academic transcript. No credit is awarded for a student's native language.
