OVERVIEW OF DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Minimum number of credits required to earn minor: 18

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A minor in French provides students with a deeper understanding of the French Language through a sustained study.

The requirements for a minor in French offered through the Department of Modern Languages & Classics are a minimum of 18 credits in the language, nine of which must be above the intermediate level

Note: FRE 102 Elementary French II or three credits of FRE 117 Accelerated French I may be counted toward the minor.
