UMaine Nursing: WGS Minor Track

To obtain a WGS minor with Nursing BSN degree, a total of 18 additional credits are needed. Nine of those credits already count within the nursing curriculum. An additional 9 credits (or three 3-credit courses) are needed within the WGS department. Below is a suggested outline to meet this criteria.
