# Access and Security

The Office of Institutional Research and Assessment (OIRA) uses Microsoft Power BI for <u>internal</u> and <u>public</u> sharing of interactive reports (aka dashboards). The University of Maine System has purchased an enterprise level license to ensure that our internal sharing is secure. Each dashboard has a "sharing level" icon to help provide <u>guidance</u> on use. The Academic Affairs and accompanying college level dashboards should follow "Sharing Limited" guidance.



Reports may be shared in a limited manner to protect businesssensitive information or findings. Limited report sharing may be internal to a department, school/college, institution, or the UMS as a whole.

Sharing guidelines are determined by a need-to-know correspondence between the data and the report recipients (department, school/college, institution, etc.).

## **Report Author Responsibilities**

The author of a data report has the responsibility of meticulously reviewing all aspects of the data and the report to ensure validity & reliability of the report prior to publication. No report should be published beyond an author's department until the author has made every reasonable effort to validate the data and report, provide appropriate context, and check accessibility & aggregation guidelines for compliance with all publication considerations detailed in the checklist & flowchart at the following link:

#### **Report Consumer Responsibilities**

Report Authors share reports directly with Report Consumers. Report Consumers should not further disseminate reports to additional individuals or audiences unless authorized to do so. The consumer(s) of any data report are responsible for maintaining confidentiality of data and any interpretations or findings gleaned from the author's original, published report. Neither the author, the author's department, nor institution may be held responsible for any misinterpretation that occurs amongst those who review and/or present the information contained in the original, published report. Derived conclusions and analyses generated from a report are the responsibility of the consumer deriving conclusions and/or deriving additional analysis.



# About the Data

The data used in the Academic Affairs Dashboard is primarily a snapshot as of the census date of each term. The data feeding interactive reports in Power BI are not "live" data and reflect the most recent census or published update.

# Disclaimers

- As noted above, the data represents a snapshot in time and may not reflect real-time information.
- Misuse or misinterpretation of data may lead to erroneous conclusions and inaccurate decisionmaking.
- Data in the dashboards are intended to provide a general overview of trends over time (or are for informational purposes only) and should not be used as the sole basis for decision-making.
- Please exercise caution when applying multiple filters. Use of filters may cause small sample sizes; unless otherwise stated, small sample sizes are not automatically hidden. We recommend maintaining a sample size of 10 or more.
- Data are not to be used for research purposes without following standard IRB guidelines.
- Please check with the dean of your college before presenting data beyond the department.

## Synced Visuals

Clicking on a part of the visual will cause other elements on the page (such as tables and visuals) to dynamically change. For example, by selecting the bar for Non-Recipients of the Pell Grant for 2022 Fall, the statistics for that selection are displayed in the table.

## Managing Filters

Filters appear on most dashboard pages and allow the user to make one or more selections to dynamically interact with the tables and visuals on the page.

### College Level Dashboard Filters

You will only be able to filter for and view the college, department, and major that you are a member of. If you do not filter for a college, department, or major, the visuals will display data for all of UMaine by default.





#### **Expanding Filters**

Some filters have more than one feature to conserve space. Click the down carrot next to a filter selection to view expanded filter options.





## **Clearing Filters**

To clear your filter selection, hover over the filter and click on the eraser in the upper right-hand corner of the filter.

Please note that if you select filters on a page and then navigate to another page without clearing your selections, the filters will carry over to the other pages.

#### Create a Filter Bookmark

You can also create a "Bookmark" with your choice of filter selections. Choose your desired filters, then click the bookmark icon in the upper right corner of the dashboard and select "Add a Personal Bookmark". You can then choose for your filters to become the default view for your dashboard.

## Copy Visual

Copy a visual to paste it in a document, PowerPoint, or email.

Hover over the top right-hand corner of a table or visual and select the copy icon.



## More Options

Hover over the top right-hand corner of a table or visual to view options.





#### Add a Comment

Add a comment on a visual or tag a coworker.



#### Sort Axis/Sort By

By selecting "Sort axis" you may change the way a visual is displayed. For example, you can sort the bars in a bar chart by increasing or decreasing number of credit hours, rather than by term.



You can do the same for a table by selecting the "Sort by" option, which allows you to sort the table by descending or ascending values of a single column.





#### Export Data

Select "Export Data" from the "More options" pane. Then, select one of the layout options – "Data with current layout" or "Summarized data" (shown below). Select "Export" to download the data into an Excel workbook.

# Using the Academic Affairs/College Dashboards for Annual Reports

Each dashboard can be used to download data needed for annual reports using the "export data" featured on the prior page.

Beginning in Summer 2023, the following annual report data can be found in the dashboards:

- Majors Enrollment Headcounts and Student Demographics
  - NOW INCLUDES:
    - Fall, Spring, and Summer headcounts.
    - Full or part-time status.
    - Filters for Career/College/Dept./Major and Degree Type
    - Residency, Online, and Honors Filters.
    - Incoming First-Time and Transfer status for Undergraduates.
  - Use the Page Selector to choose from:
    - Major Enrollment Headcounts:
      - Enrollment Headcounts Single Term
      - Enrollment Headcounts Over Time (Fall 2014 Fall 2023)
    - Student Demographics:
      - Student Demographics Single Term
      - Student Demographics Over Time (Fall 2017 Fall 2023)
  - Apply filters for College/Dept./Major or Degree Type

#### - Retention and Graduation Rates

- NOW INCLUDES:
  - Filtering to the level of college, department, and major.
  - Transfers and part-time students.
  - Demographics breakouts.
- Use the Page Selector to choose from:
  - Retention/Grad Rates Overview (UGRD): This tab provides a comprehensive table formatted similarly to prior year's annual report packages.
  - Term 2 Persistence (UGRD)
  - Retention to Y2 (UGRD)
  - Grad Rates: 4Y (UGRD)
  - Grad Rates: 6Y (UGRD)

Select "Export data" from the "More Options" menu by hovering over the table or visual and selecting the three ellipses.

This should open an Excel file containing the data with any applied filters you have selected.
