**Notes:**

1. These tables report student credit hours (SCHs) offered by the college or academic unit, regardless of the instructor's home unit. For example, all courses having a PSY prefix are considered to be offered by the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences (LAS), even if an instructor from the College of Education & Human Development taught a PSY course. Similarly, all courses having a prefix of PSY are considered to be offered by the Department of Psychology (the LAS unit where PSY resides) even if an instructor from another LAS unit taught a PSY course. SCHs generated by multidisciplinary courses are attributed to the academic unit of the instructor teaching the course.
2. Honors SCHs are credited to the Honors College -- with the exception of HON 498 and HON 499, where, when possible, the home unit of the advisor is credited.
3. Courses offered via DLL include distance (e.g., online, videoconferencing, and video streaming), CED, Academ-e, and Bridge Year course sections.
4. SCHs for cross-listed courses are reported in the unit of the instructor teaching the course. If the instructor's academic unit is not the unit offering the course, the SCHs are reported in the unit of the course with the highest enrollment.
5. Each year comprises fall and spring semesters.
