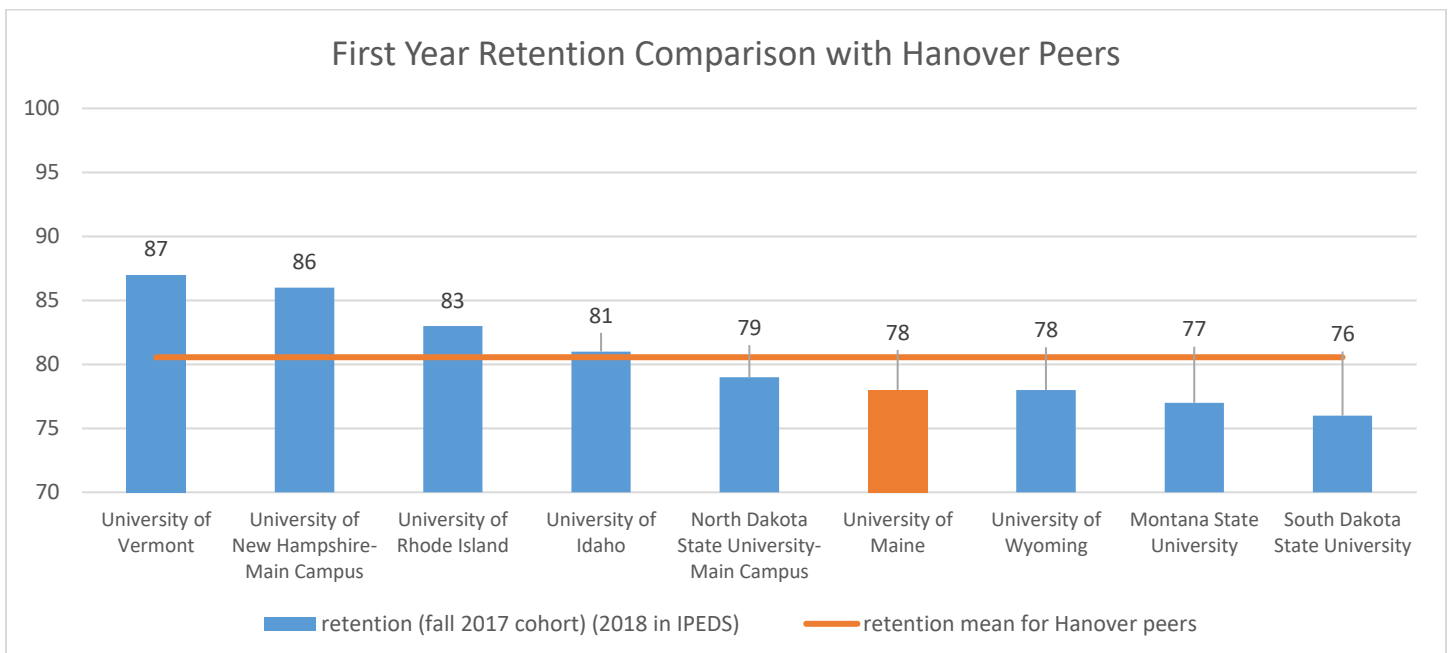
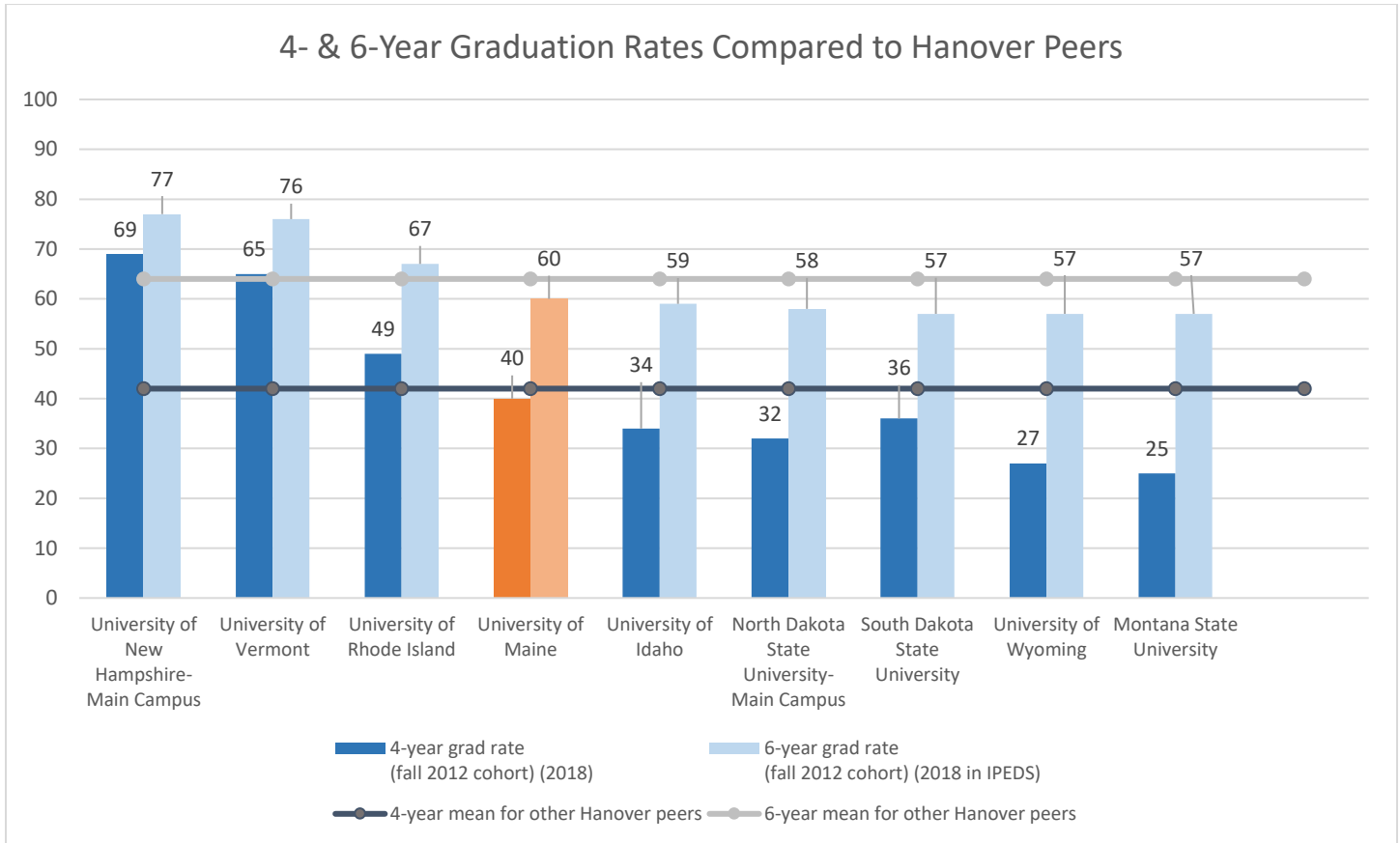


UMaine Graduation & Retention Rates in Context
