



The Office of Institutional Research and Assessment offers a secure, internal, self-service interactive data dashboard for Student Evaluation of Teaching (SET) survey responses.

Access is managed at the user level. For access, email ryan.a.weatherbee@maine.edu. Each user (i.e. dean) will only be able to view SET data for their college.

To access the College Student Evaluation of Teaching dashboards:

1. Navigate to [College SET Dashboard UM](#) or [College SET Dashboard UMM](#), depending on your campus.
2. Sign in with your existing UMaine email and password.

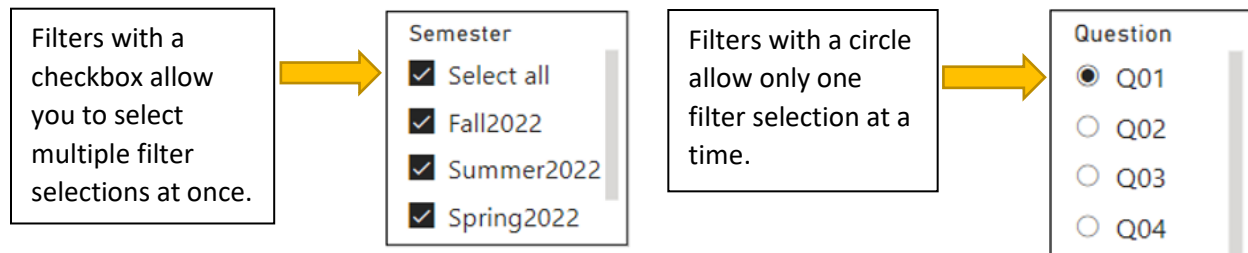

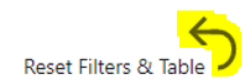
Managing Filters:



If you select more than one option in the Semester filter, the classes will have the semester they occur in their name (example below is blurred for security).

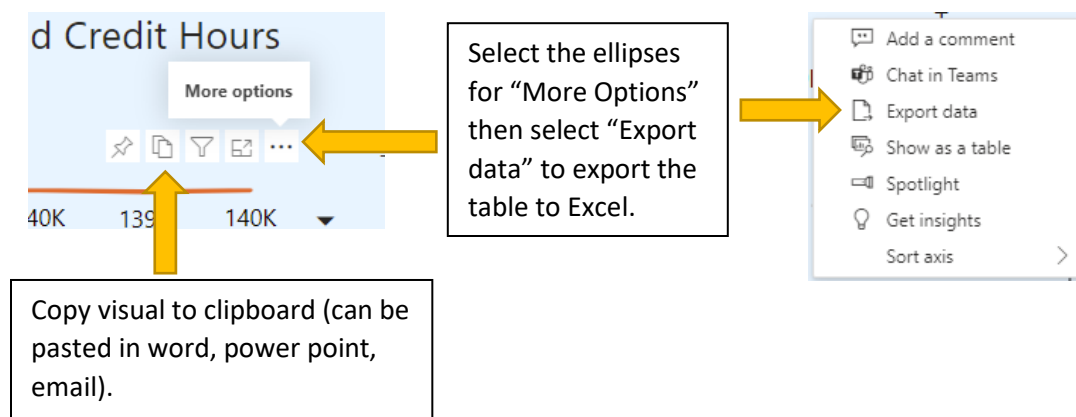


To clear your filter selections, click on the arrow button in the bottom left corner of the dashboard.
