Wintergreen Gaultheria procumbens



- Small herb.
- When broken leaves will have a minty fragrance.
- Harvest leaves and berries.
- Harvest in the summer.

Bunchberry Cornus canadensis



- Small herb.
- Harvest berries.
- Harvest in the summer.

Eastern Hemlock Tsuga canadensis



- Evergreen tree.
- Harvest needles for tea rich in vitamin C.
- Harvest any time but best when new in the spring.
- *NOTE: The Eastern Hemlock is not poisonous. "Poisonous hemlock" is a totally different plant.*

Hobblebush Viburnum alnifolium



- Shrub
- Harvest berry like fruits.
- Harvest in the fall.

Wild Strawberry Fragaria virginiana



- Small herb.
- Harvest berries.
- Harvest in late spring into summer.
