ESCAPE FROM MOUNTAIN VIEW CORRECTIONAL FACILITY

The Department of Corrections confirms the escape/walk-off of prisoner Arnold Nash from the Mountain View Correctional Facility in Charleston, Maine.

Arnold Nash, age 65, was last seen on September 13, 2018 at approximately 8:20 p.m. in the minimum-security unit of the facility and is still believed to be local to the area. He was last seen wearing blue jeans, a white t-shirt, and light blue shirt. Nash is 5'6" tall and weighs approximately 160 pounds.

Arnold Nash is currently serving a forty-five year sentence for Murder and Robbery, which began on May 29, 1992. His release date was December 14, 2019.

Arnold Nash should not be approached if seen by the public, anyone with information on the possible whereabouts of Arnold Nash is asked to contact local law enforcement immediately.
