Exempt	 Yes	May not carry more passengers than the unit is designed for.
Motorcycle	Motor vehicle with seat or saddle, 2 or 3 wheels 10" or greater, motor capacity of more than 50cc, or electric motor with more than 1,500 watt capacity.	Must have motorcycle endorsement on license	Must display inspection certificate on license plate.	 Yes	All rules of the road apply.
Motorized Bicycle	<p>A bike or tricycle that:</p> <p>a) may have pedals for human propulsion; b) has a motor attached to a wheel with no more than 1.5 brake horsepower and has engine capacity for 25 mph max. speed on level surface;</p>	Must have valid license of any class or a motorcycle license or permit.	Exempt	 No	Must operate to the right of the roadway, cannot travel faster than 20 mph.
Motorized Scooter	A scooter than has 2 or 3 wheels less than 10", motor that has displacement of less than 25cc or electric motor not more than 750 watts.	Must have valid license of any class or a motorcycle license or permit.	Exempt	 No	Must operate to the right of the roadway, cannot travel faster than 20 mph.
