Incident Description:

On Friday, April 24, 2026, the Augusta Police Department received a vague online threat over social media indicating a threat at the baseball fields on Piggery Road in Augusta. Augusta PD is currently investigating this incident. As the UMA Baseball Team frequently uses these fields for practices and games, please avoid this area.

At this time, no information has been received posing a threat to members of the UMA Baseball Team, but all UMA students, staff, and faculty are asked to avoid these fields until further notice. This Timely Warning Notification is required under the Jeanne Clery Act.

UMPD reminds our UMA community of the following safety guidance:

- Continue normal activities while remaining aware of your surroundings
- If you are afraid for your safety or the safety of others, call 911 immediately
- Do not hesitate to contact UMPD to report any information related to this incident
