

2017 Maine Attorney General Child Protection Internship Program



The internship will involve working two days per week in Bangor for 14 weeks, either over the summer or in the Fall semester (specific days TBD). The student will be assigned to the office of the Maine Attorney General, focused on child protection cases. Six academic credit hours are granted for the internship.

Applications are open to all UMaine Juniors and Seniors regardless of major. Candidates must be able to pass a criminal background check and a child protective background check. Applicants may apply for summer and/or fall with different people interning for these times.
