UMaine's regional campus is in the heart of Machias, a small, historic New England town situated beside the Machias River estuary that meets the Gulf of Maine. Surrounded by miles of wild blueberry fields, forests, pristine lakes and rugged, rocky Atlantic coastline, the area offers outdoor recreation opportunities for all seasons.

UMaine Machias is less than 10 miles from Jasper Beach and within walking distance of the Down East Sunrise Trail, an 87-mile scenic rail-to-trail corridor open to hikers, bikers, skiers, snowmobilers, ATVers, horseback riders and dogsledders.
