### Research Learning Experiences (RLE)

#### UMaine and UMaine Machias Fall Pilot Program

- 31 sections
- ~300 students
- 36 faculty members are teaching RLE courses
- The pilot spans the arts, engineering, business, humanities, social and biophysical sciences
- RLEs were paired with an intensive summer bridge experience

#### Testing continues on campus

- Testing takes place at multiple satellite locations
- On campus testing 4 days per week
  - (Monday Thursday) in Estabrooke Hall
- 12 hour turn around on test results

Vaccination Clinics each Wednesday in the Memorial Union





### How are we doing with COVID?



- MOU signed with all UMS bargaining units
- Vaccinations verified
  - 80% full-time employees
  - 95% residential students
- COVID Operations Group notified of positives three ways:
  - Asymptomatic testing results
  - Cutler Heath Center (symptomatic)
  - Self reports

- Active known cases (as of 9/27/21)
  - 39
- Since the start of operations (Since March 2020)
  - 135 Isolating or quarantining (employees)
