The Office of the Vice President for Research and Dean of the Graduate School is pleased to announce a new proposal development initiative and faculty incentive program designed to increase the number and quality of UMaine funding proposals submitted to the National Institutes of Health. The program is open to all ranks of faculty as well as soft money researchers at UMaine and incentives will include dedicated proposal development and review services, access to senior faculty with NIH experience, and a competitive mini-grant program for course buy-out and/or short-term NIH grant consultants.

Eligibility requirements include:

1. Attend the OVRPDGS sponsored NIH Workshop
2. Work directly with Grant Development Office Staff
3. Adhere to UMaine's proposal submission timeline

This workshop will provide an overview of NIH funding opportunities, further details on the faculty incentive program, and advice from an expert panel of UMaine faculty who have had funding success with NIH.
