

Directions

To minimize traffic congestion, three routes have been mapped for traffic flow. Upon entering campus, follow the colored signage (using the color-coded building code) to your residence hall move-in area. You must follow the correct route (A, B or C) or you will end up in the wrong line of traffic.

Route A:


- From I-95, take exit 191 for Kelley Road
- From the southbound lane, turn LEFT off the ramp
- From the northbound lane, turn RIGHT off the ramp
- Drive 1 mile to the traffic light
- Turn LEFT onto Route 2
- Drive 2.5 miles to the third traffic light
- Bear RIGHT onto Route 2/Park Street
- At the traffic circle, take the Rangeley Road exit (with Bangor Savings Bank on your right)
- Continue straight on Rangeley Road and follow signs for your residence hall

Route B:

- From I-95, take exit 193 for Stillwater Avenue
- From the southbound lane, turn LEFT off the ramp
- From the northbound lane, merge RIGHT off the ramp
- Stay in the RIGHT lane
- Drive 1 mile to the fourth traffic light
- Approach the light in the RIGHT lane
- Turn RIGHT onto College Avenue (by Maine Savings)
- Follow College Avenue to campus
- Turn LEFT onto Long Road (just past Alfond Arena)
- Follow the signs to your residence hall

Route C:

- From I-95, take exit 191 for Kelley Road
- From the southbound lane, turn LEFT off the ramp
- From the northbound lane, turn RIGHT off the ramp
- Drive 1 mile to the traffic light
- Turn LEFT onto Route 2
- · Drive 2.5 miles to the third traffic light
- As you approach the light, bear LEFT
- Turn LEFT onto College Avenue
- Go to the second UMaine entrance
- Turn RIGHT onto Sebec Road
- Keep RIGHT at the fork
- Follow the signs to your residence hall

Preparing your den:

Your room

- Get a checklist of what to bring here: umaine.edu/housing/what-to-bring-what-notto-bring/
- Room assignments: Available through student's MyHousing account

• Room and bed info

- Room: Room diagrams, details on windows and closets, and photos at umaine.edu/housing/ residence-halls
- **Bed:** Mattresses are Twin XL. Mattress is about 6" thick. Beds come mid-lofted (27.5" from floor)
- **Charging:** You'll use your smartphone for your Mobile MaineCard so charging is important.
 - Charging station outside Union Central
 - Purchase a power bank or charging station to keep your phone powered up
- **Bike storage:** Most residence halls have bike storage rooms and bike racks in front of the halls.
 - Bike repair stations available at: Fogler Library, New Balance Recreation Center, MaineBound Building, Sawyer Building.

Getting here:

Parking (umaine.edu/parking)

- Buy a permit (\$50) to park on campus.
 - Campus residents receive a **red** permit. Commuter students receive a **black** permit. These denote the lot you must park in.
 - Visitors must have passes. Get one at Parking & Transportation Services (DTAV Community Center) or University Police (Rangeley Road)
- During UMaine's winter parking ban (Nov. 1–May 1), blue and black lots will be closed to parking from midnight to 6 a.m.
