



Requirements for the Physical Science 6-12 certificate (350S)

Please see below for the requirements to qualify for both a conditional and/or professional certificate. Please note that the endorsement code is 350S, which will be used throughout the application process. If you believe you qualify for either a conditional or professional certificate, please submit an initial application through our online MEIS system.

Conditional Certificate (3 year) requirements include:

- (1) All of Section A

Conditional Certificate (3 year) (through the transitional pathway) requirements include:

- (1) A valid Professional Maine teaching certificate
- (2) 9 semester hours of section A

Five-year professional certificate requirements include completion of all sections below:

NOTE: The number in () indicates the number of semester hours required.		
Section A:		
1. At least a bachelor's degree		
2. Physical Sciences (e.g., Chemistry, physics, geology, earth science, soil science, astronomy, meteorology, oceanography) (24)		
3. Background check approval (CHRC) – based on fingerprints		
Section B:		
1. Teaching Students with Exceptionalities in the Regular Classroom (3)		
2. Secondary Science methods (3)		
3. Diversity-centered content related to today's classroom (3) (e.g., Culturally responsive teaching, multicultural education, intercultural education, second language acquisition or world language teaching methods)		
4. Development (3) (human development, educational psychology, developmental psychology, or child development)		
5. Student Teaching (waived upon one school year of successful teaching under a valid certificate)
