1. Full-time Advanced Standing MSW students must complete three electives. Students who wish to become licensed at the Licensed Clinical Social Work level must choose SWK 580 (Psychopathology) as one of their three electives and another elective that meets the requirements for clinical social work.
2. Full-time Advanced Standing MSW students who wish to complete the advanced year field internships (SWK 695) by doing a Summer Block Field experience (May to August, 35 hours per week during their final semester in the program) must petition for a change in their Program of Study by submitting an application for Summer Block Field to Nancy Kelly, Field Coordinator during their summer bridging courses.
