- 1. Online-Hybrid MSW students must complete three electives. Students who wish to become licensed at the Licensed Clinical Social Work level must choose SWK 580 (Psychopathology) as one of their three electives. Students may take electives in any semester they choose, though suggested semesters are first spring, second summer, and third fall.
- 2. If you have never taken a research or statistics class, you will need to do so before taking SWK 691.
- 3. Online-blended MSW students who want to complete the Specialization Year Field practicum (SWK 695) by doing a Summer Block Field practicum (May to August, 38-40 hours per week, during their final semester in the program) must petition for a change in their Program of Study. To petition for a change in their Program of Study, students should 1) attend a field application information meeting, and 2) submit the MSW Specialization Year Field Petition for Change in Program of Study form to the field team via TK20 by December 1<sup>st</sup> of their second fall semester.
- 4. During the fall and spring semesters, MSW students must be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) graduate credit hours in order to be eligible for financial aid (including student loans). During the summer semester, MSW students must be enrolled in a minimum of three (3) graduate credit hours in order to be eligible for financial aid (including student loans).
- 5. For most courses you will be required to attend in-person classes on the Orono University Campus on two Saturdays each semester.
