Meet at least once per semester with the executive board or officer group. Stay updated on institutional news and help keep student leaders in the loop.



Attend general membership meetings at least once per semester to stay connected with the broader group.



Trip & Travel Support

Help with planning trips to conferences or off-campus events. Provide guidance on the Student Travel Policy. Be a go-to for questions about officer transitions and team development.



Advise on risk management, event safety, and responsible decision-making. Stay informed and support adherence to the Student Conduct Code and university expectations. If you become aware of a crime or serious concern, report it to UMPD and Student Life promptly.



Offer institutional knowledge and historical context. Help student leaders think long-term and make informed decisions.



Educate the group on UMaine policies, procedures, and liability concerns. Be a resource to help navigate university systems and set the group up for success.



Facilitate at least one goal-setting or assessment session each year with the executive board or membership. Help the group reflect, celebrate, and plan forward!



Help your organization stay active on campus! The update form is due on CampusGroups *every* semester. Two missed update forms? The club gets deactivated and starts the process over to become reestablished.
