## Fire Evacuation Procedure



## Quarantine

In the event of a fire alarm, students in quarantine should do the following:

- 1. Shelter in place while the fire alarm is activated until instructed to evacuate by the fire department or University personnel.
  - If students SEE or SMELL smoke, fire, or any other signs of danger, EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY.
- 2. If evacuation is necessary, students should follow the labeled evacuation route for their area.
  - Bear paws will be colored end labeled in each hallway to denote which route students should follow.
  - Students will follow their colored arrows along the hallway to their exit.
  - Students will gather at the pre-established and labeled rally points outside of each hallway exit.
- 3. During evacuation and while at the rally point, students will maintain 6 feet of social distance and will need to wear appropriate face coverings.
  - If the students are unable to bring a face covering outside with them, staff will be able to provide one.
- 4. Students will remain outside until instructed by the fire department or University staff to re-enter the building.

## Isolation

In the event of a fire alarm, students in isolation should do the following:

- 1. All students will evacuate upon hearing/seeing the fire alarm.
- 2. Students will evacuate the building toward the DTAV/Patch Quad.
- 3. The rally point for students in isolation will be on the DTAV/Patch Quad.
- 4. During evacuation and while at the rally point, students will maintain 6 feet of social distance and will need to wear appropriate face coverings.
  - If the students are unable to bring a face covering outside with them, staff will be able to provide one.
- 5. Students will remain outside until instructed by the fire department or University staff to re-enter the building.
