Do NOT call UVAC directly for service

When is it appropriate to call 911?

Call 911 if someone:

- is unconscious
- is having trouble breathing
- is uncontrollably bleeding
- has taken a blow to the head
- or if you are unsure if the situation is an emergency

Be ready to tell the dispatcher:

- Exactly where you are
- The nature of the emergency
- If the person is breathing
- If the person is conscious

Medical amnesty:

- The Medical Amnesty Program is designed to allow individuals to seek help in an emergency
- Both the caller and the patient are protected from criminal proceedings by state law
