GENERAL STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION
“UNIFY THE SENATOR GPA REQUIREMENT”**

AN ACT TO: Amend the FEPC Guidelines to reflect the correct GPA requirements to be a Senator.

WHEREAS, The FEPC Guidelines currently define eligibility as “All members in good standing of the activity fee paying, undergraduate student body who meet the Student Government constitutional requirements for candidacy, and hold a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA (not including the semester of candidacy) shall be eligible to run for an executive election”; and

WHEREAS, The Standing Rules, Rule II, Section 2, Subsection B, Line 1 currently reads

1. A student shall be considered for a senator position if he or she is enrolled as a full time student at the University of Maine and has a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0. If the candidate is in his or her first year at the University of Maine, the most recent college or university cumulative GPA must be a minimum of a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. If no college cumulative GPA is available, the student will be able to serve on senate for the first term and will continue for each semester thereafter, provided that their cumulative GPA is at least 2.0”; and

WHEREAS, The Senator application packet lists a requirement of 2.0

RESOLVED, The FEPC Guidelines, Article **III**, Section 3, Subsection A, will be amended to read:

“All members in good standing of the activity fee paying, undergraduate student body who meet the Student Government constitutional requirements for candidacy, and hold a minimum **2.5 2.0** cumulative GPA (not including the semester of candidacy) shall be eligible to run for an **executive senator** election”


