AN ACT TO: review the Elected SEC Senator position.

WHEREAS, the Elected SEC senator has been pivotal to the Student Entertainment Division this academic year; and

WHEREAS, a second AVPSE was not hired for the 2026-2027 academic year, leaving a hole in the needs of the Student Entertainment Division. This past year, that hole was filled with assigning the elected senator additional responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the elected senator can be given tasks outside of committee meetings such as: managing smaller events on campus, assisting the VPSE and AVPSE in their events, actively table to gauge student interests, and anything else assigned; and

WHEREAS, there are many senators who could take on this responsibility, however the elected senator would be required to assume some of these responsibilities; giving the entertainment division a consistent aid throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, when giving a senator more responsibilities, their compensation should be raised accordingly.

WHEREAS, should this resolution fail, all changes to the Standing Rules through 46S-POL-98-09-30-2025 shall be reversed.

RESOLVED, The senate has reviewed the Elected Senator of the Student Entertainment Committee and deems it appropriate for the continuation of this position without any changes.
