

2022 UM Student Symposium: Call for Abstracts

Thank you for your interest in the 2022 UMaine Student Symposium.

The Center for Undergraduate Research and Graduate Student Government invites the submission of student research and creative activities abstracts from all disciplines to be presented at the 2022 UMaine Student Symposium. All presentations will be submitted electronically and posted on the UMSS website for viewing and judging (umaine.edu/umss). Students are also highly encouraged to present a poster at the in-person event on April 15th, 2022.

Abstract submissions will only be accepted using this form. Please be sure that you have worked with your Faculty Mentor to develop your abstract. Your abstract will be sent to your Faculty Mentor for approval after submission. The abstract should be 250 words or approximately 1500 characters and describe the focus, method or process, and outcomes of the project following discipline/program-specific standards as advised by faculty mentors.

Entries must be authored by one or more undergraduate or graduate students from the University of Maine or the University of Maine at Machias, and must be endorsed by a faculty mentor. All abstracts are sent to faculty mentors for approval. All email correspondences will be sent to the submitting student author completing this form. If you are presenting with more than one presenter (group posters, oral presentations, or exhibits), as the submitting author, you are responsible for passing all email correspondences and information to your co-presenters.
