- 1.) Application (1-4 Days)
 - a. Fill out an application and send it to the Program Director before the deadline.
 - b. If asked, review your setlist, make revisions
 - c. Schedule an interview with the Program Director
- 2.) Interview (1-2 Weeks)
 - a. Attend the interview, start thinking about show name, time, etc.
 - b. Provide availability for Radio 101
- 3.) Radio 101 (1-2 weeks after applications are due)
 - a. Attend Radio 101
 - b. Complete DJ Responsibility Form/Policy Comprehension Guide
 - c. Schedule show time
 - d. Name your show
 - e. Activate your Spinitron account
 - f. Sign up for shadowing
- 4.) Shadowing (~1 Week)
 - a. Shadow Another DJ
 - b. Follow up with Program Director with any and all questions
 - c. Write and submit a first draft Promo for your show
- 5.) Getting on the Air (~ 3 Days)
 - a. Reach out to Program Director with any questions/concerns
 - b. Double check card access, Schedule, Spinitron etc.
 - c. First show (A staff member will sit in with you, don't worry!)
- 6.) Following Up
 - a. Check in with Program Director with any remaining questions
 - b. Complete Onboarding Survey
 - c. Make to follow all guidelines, policies, etc. going forward
