The University of Maine's student radio station, WMEB 91.9 FM, is seeking an individual who can keep WMEB's website up to date and organize, maintain, and manage the station's physical media collection.

Specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Maintain and organize WMEB's physical media collection.
- Listen to, label, and organize new physical media (primarily CD's) sent by promoters, labels, and independent artists. Incorporate the CDs into Studio A's BINS (new physical media).
- Develop tools/methods to aid the organization of the library and promote our collection.
- Work closely with Music Directors in determining what media should be located in BINS, the library, or given away.
- Collaborate with Event Coordinator to develop/update WMEB's website.
- Oversee updating of RoboDJ.
- Promote WMEB philosophy of providing unique content for the greater Bangor/Orono community.
- Foster connections between music-show DJ's and staff.
- Communicate and engage effectively with staff, participating in staff meetings, events, and other related activities regarding WMEB.
